

NOTICE

ELECTIONEERING

No person may electioneer within one hundred (100) feet of a polling place. However, the restriction does not apply to private property, exiting polling, or bumper stickers on vehicles that are present for a reasonable amount of time in which to vote. 31 KAR 4:180.

A bumper sticker is defined as measuring within 14 inches by 5 inches, affixed to a person's vehicle while parked within or passing through a distance of one hundred (100) feet of any entrance to the building in which a voting machine is located if that entrance is unlocked and is used by voters during the hours voting is being conducted in the building for a reasonable amount of time in which to vote.
